CONTENT AND SCOPE

The material in the A. W. Binder Collection is extensive in scope, demonstrating the many aspects of Binder's rich and creative life. The largest section of the collection is that of liturgical and non-liturgical musical manuscripts, both vocal and instrumental. Thee manuscripts are sketches and drafts of almost all of Binder's entire compositional output. The designation of "sketch" or "draft" is only a loose definition, except that the latter represents a more complete stage in the evolution of a piece.

In addition to the manuscripts, the collection contains Binder's lectures and writings, a number of which were published. They reflect his teaching activities at the 92nd Street Y, the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue, the Jewish Institute of Religion, and the School of Sacred Music of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. His numerous public lectures and radio broadcasts are also represented in the collection. A significant amount of material concerns Binder's activities as chairman of the Hymnal Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis for the Third Edition of the Union Hymnal.

On a more personal note are many of his diaries, in particular those of some of his visits to Israel. The final category is correspondence; Binder's widespread contacts, not only in America, but also in Europe and Israel, are illustrated.

In sum, the collection provides a vitally important source for the historian and musicologist researching into Binder's life and music.

An addendum consisting of the full orchestral score of "A Goat in Chelm", as well parts, was appended after the collection was processed; it does not appear in the index.

BIOGRAPHY

Born on the Lower East Side of New York City on January 9, 1985 into a family of hazzanim, Abraham Wolf Binder participated in his father's choir at the age of four, and then joined the choir of Cantor Abraham Frachtenberg, where he sang until he was fourteen. His early music studies were at the Settlement Music School, and he graduated from Townsend Harris High School. Later music studies were at Columbia University, and he received a Bachelor of Music degree from the New York College of Music in 1920. Binder began his professional career as organist and music director at Temple Beth-El in Greenpoint, Brooklyn, and then Adath Israel in the Bronx. In 1916 he formed the Hadassah Choral Union, and in 1917 was asked to organize the Y School of Music at the 92nd Street YM-YWHA, which he directed until his retirement in 1966. Rabbi Stephen S. Wise invited him in 1921 to join the faculty of the newly formed Jewish Institute of Religion as an instructor in Jewish Music, and the following year engaged him to be music director at the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue, a post he held until his death.

Early on, Binder published instrumental, choral, and liturgical works, and his first Sabbath liturgical collection was issued in 1928. Two years later, he was asked by the Central Conference of American Rabbbis to be editor for the fully revised Union Hymnal which for decades constituted the musical guidepost of Reform temples. When the Jewish Institute of Religion merged with the Hebrew Union College in 1947, Binder became Professor of Jewish Liturgical Music. In 1944 he helped establish the National Jewish Music Council, and in 1948 was a co-founder of the School of Sacred Music at Hebrew Union College.

Throughout the years he was a collector, arranger, and performer of Hebrew folk songs. An ardent Zionist, he supported emerging Jewish music in Israel. A prodigious composer of sacred and secular vocal and instrumental works, Binder was also associated with many leading musicians. He corresponded with Ernest Bloch, and helped to dedicate the 1956 Jewish Music Festival honoring him. In 1951, Binder presented the Sacred Service of Darius Milhaud over CBS Radio. Binder himself was the recipient of numerous awards, such as the Frank L. Weil Award granted in 1960 by the National Jewish Welfare Board for distinguished contribution to the development of American Jewish Culture. In 1965 he was honored at the Jewish Music Festival.

In 1921 Binder married Anna Friedman, a pianist and social worker. They had two children, Leah, who died in 1968, and Hadassah. Following Anna's death in 1936 Binder married Priscilla Dreyer, a niece of the German-Jewish Talmudic scholar Lazarus Goldschmidt. She died in 1953. A third marriage, to Helen F. Drayton in 1956, ended in divorce in 1956. Binder took ill on Friday evening. September 23 1966, while conducting the music of Kol Nidre at the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue, and died that following October 9th.

- 1953 Doctor of Hebrew Letters, honoris causa, conferred by HUC-JIR
- 1960 Recipient of Frank L. Weil Award for his distinguished contribution to American Jewish culture
- 1963 Founded the Jewish Litugical Music Society
- 1965 Jewish Music Festival of the National Jewish Music Council dedicated to the "Renaissance of Jewish Music in America: The Life and Work of AWB"

Attached: copy of a typed letter from Artur Holde to Dimitri Mitropoulos

May 24, 1950 (to Mitropoulos); May 25, 1950 (to Binder)

Sends Binder a copy of Holde's letter to the director of the New York Philharmonic, in which Holde praised Binder's compositions and requested permission to have Binder contact the director about potential performances of his music.

This appears to be a draft of the anthology. His historical explanations and lyrics are pasted in on separate scraps of paper; large blank spaces above and below these captions were presumably originally filled by sheet music (also presumably pasted in on separate scraps of paper), which has since been removed. It is unknown what happened with the sheet music.

A. W. Binder Collection - Box 46

Card catalogue of bibliographic citations, perhaps used for compiling Binder's *Bibliography of Jewish Vocal Music* (National Jewish Music Council, 1958). All citations are hand-written in A. W. Binder's handwriting (some in pencil, and some in ink).

Some items are contained in a hard metal case (labeled "recipes") and are organized by tabs: "Passover", "Hagaddah", "Occident", "Syn. + Hymns", "Zong on Music", "On Hymnals", "Facts on Hymnody", "Trans. of Hymns", etc.

Others are stored in a box far too large for them, and are thus becoming disorganized.
