

### CONSECRATION SERVICES.

# FRIDAY, ELUL 13th, 5630.

September, 9th, 1870.

On the entrance of the Ministers and those carrying the Holy Scrolls, the Congregation will rise.

### 1. ANTHEM. (Hebrew.)

The Recitative by Rev. Isidore Frankel, Reader of the Congregation.

PEN to me the gates of righteousness, I will enter into them, I will give thanks unto the Lord.

This is the gate of the Lord, by which the righteous may enter.

I will thank Thee, for Thou hast afflicted me, and art become my salvation. The stone which the builders rejected, is become the chief corner-stone. From the Lord is this come to pass, it is marvellous in our eyes. This is the day which the Lord hath made; we will be glad and rejoice thereon. (PS. CXVIII, 19—24.)

### 3. PROCESSION.

[The Holy Ark being opened, the Scrolls will be carried through the Synagogue and then placed therein, during which the following Hebrew Hymns will be sung:]

"Rise up, O Lord, and let Thy enemies be scattered, and let those that hate Thee, flee before Thy face."—For out of Zion shall go forth the Law, and the word of the Lord out of Jerusalem.

אמע Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is One.

One is our God, great our Lord, the Holy One is His name.

ארלו Magnify ye the Lord with me, and let us extol His name in united chorus.

Thine, O Lord, is the greatness, might and glory, the victory and majesty, yea, all that is in the heavens and on the earth; Thine is the kingdom, and Thine is he who exalts himself as the head above all. Exalt ye the Lord our God, and bow yourselves down before His footstool; He is holy. Exalt ye the Lord our God, and bow yourselves down before His holy mount; for holy is the Lord our God.

אומר And when the Ark rested, he (Moses) said:
"Dwell, O Lord, among the many thousands
of Israel."—Arise, O Lord, unto Thy resting
place, Thou and the Ark of Thy strength.
Let Thy priests be clothed with righteousness,

and let Thy pious ones shout for joy. For the sake of David, Thy servant, turn not away the face of Thy anointed.—For a good instruction I have given you, forsake ye not my Thorah.—A tree of life is she to those that lay hold on her; and those that embrace her are happy. Her ways are ways of grace; and all her paths are peace.—Cause us, O Lord, to return unto Thee, and we will return, renew Thou our days as of old.
