DIGEST

In order to gauge the cultural contribution of the American Jew, it is imperative that we have a bibliography of works published by Jews or about Jews.

In 1926, the American Jewish Historical Society published an invaluable reference aid and handbook for students of American Jewish history entitled An American Jewish Bibliography, Being a List of Books and Pamphlets by Jews or Relating to Them Printed in the United States From the Establishment of the Press in the Colonies Until 1850.

The compiler of this monumental pioneer work, Dr. A.S.W. Rosenbach was conscious of the fact that his was not a definitive work but, at most, "a nucleus for further study." He expressed the hope that other scholars would supplement his bibliography. In 1954, Dr. Jacob R. Marcus, Director of the American Jewish Archives published just such a supplement, which consisted of titles unknown to Rosenbach, which were in the possession of the Hebrew Union College Library.

In 1958, Edwin Wolf 2nd, of Philadelphia, in response to an invitation to contribute to a jubilee volume published in commemoration of the Archives' tenth anniversary, added considerably to the Rosenbach and Marcus bibliographies.

In his preface, Rosenbach laments the fact that his bibliography only goes as far as the year 1850. "The second half of the nineteenth century... would prove perhaps a more interesting subject... and it is hoped that new hands will take up the work

where I left off." Mine are the new hands.

This thesis is a continuation of the Rosenbach, Marcus, and Wolf bibliographies containing titles of books, pamphlets, periodicals and broadsides by Jews or relating to them published in the United States from 1851-1875.

In my thesis, I have taken into consideration the Wolf criticisms of the earlier bibliographies which "devoted much space to books of only peripheral Jewish importance, such as Christian theological works on Old Testament themes, to poems and essays with a biblical, but no essentially Jewish, content, and to comprehensive religious histories where the Jewish interest is limited to biblical history as a prelude to Christianity." Such works have been omitted from this bibliography.

In addition to the 706 entries of the bibliography, I have included separate indexes of authors, non-Hebrew titles, Hebrew titles, subjects, place of publications, printers, and publishers, as a further means of facilitating the study of Jewish Americana.
